## Orphan Children in Nepal Needs your Support..

**Why Sponsor a Child's Education?** Nepal is one of the poorest and least developed countries in the world, with an estimated 30% of Nepalis living below the poverty line - about 82% of the population lives on less than US\$2 per day. Sadly, this means that many children miss out on receiving a full education. So they remain stuck in the cycle of poverty, with little or no opportunities for career development.

Sponsorship through VIN provides children with the invaluable opportunity to begin or continue their education and the possibility to realize their full potential.

## Sponsorship Options



**Sponsorship Options** VIN sponsors the most disadvantaged children in the community: including orphans, conflict victims and children from extremely poor backgrounds or lower castes. Children most in need of sponsorship are identified in conjunction with Head Teachers, Village Development Committees / Ward Chairpersons and a community representative.

Sponsors can either allow VIN to select a child most urgently in need of sponsorship or choose a child to sponsor from one of the following three groups - Orphanage Children, Conflict Victim Children and Disadvantaged Children from Very Poor Backgrounds.

## How Much Does Sponsorship Costs?



**How Much Does Sponsorship Cost?** Full sponsorship costs 230 USD per year and includes admission fees, examination fees, monthly tuition fees, two sets of uniforms (shirt, pants, sweater, tie, belt, shoes, book bag, etc), stationery and book medication, children's club support, support for community development activities and an administrative charge (includes correspondence, follow up and monitoring of the sponsored child).

Partial sponsorship costs 100 USD per year and includes stationery and books.

## What Will the Sponsor Receive



A photo Album of their sponsored child; An electronic copy of their sponsored child's progress report a year; Electronic copies of any letters, cards, greetings and other correspondence from their sponsored child, should they wish to receive this; VIN's Annual Report and Newsletter. **"In addition VIN will regularly:** monitors children's progress, provides income generative programs for the sponsored children's parents and conducts follow up meetings.

## How Do I Become A Sponsor?

To become a sponsor, log on to the VIN website, [click here](#). On the RIGHT side of the page header, click "the options available" Sponsor a Disadvantaged Community Child, an Orphanage Child or a Conflict Victim Child. When you click on one of the links, you may view photos and profiles of the children who need sponsorship. When you have chosen the child you would like to sponsor, click "SPONSOR THIS CHILD".

Continue the work you started during your post with VIN. Education is the key to change. Making education available to ALL the children of Jitpur will ensure a brighter future for the entire community.

## How can you SEND Money?

**There are 3 options to send money, Paypal, Western Union / IME / Money Gram, Wire Transfer to Bank**

**Paypal:** This is one of the most trusted online payment gateway. Please click here to proceed for payment, [click here](#) to donate.

**Western Union / IME / Money Gram:** are the fastest ways to send money abroad. You may require going to their Outlets and filling up a form to send cash. Their charges are fairly cheaper than wire transfer. You can use one of VIN's board member's name as receiver and email us the MTCN (unique number to withdraw money) code. This may cost about 10USD in to send

**Wire Transfer:** You need SWIFT code for this service. They take 3 to 5 business days to send money and they are more expensive than Western Union / IME / Money Gram. Please ask to the bank for their hour charges to send money to Nepal. If you use our bank's partner bank to send money (like City bank, Standard Chartered bank), will be cheaper, please click here to learn the partner banks of Everest bank Nepal Ltd.
