Areas of support



Women's empowerment

We empower women to improve their quality of life by:

- Supplying them with economic tools
- Educating them on their rights and life skills

Projects: Education (literacy, rights & life skills), Micro-credit and income generation

Children's development

We protect the rights of children by:

- Providing them with access to basic education
- Developing their life skills & creativity

Projects: Child care: Early Childhood Development Centre (ECD) & Orphanage homes, Children's Clubs, School attendance (sponsorships, teacher training, good parenting education, basic infra-structure: construction of classrooms, buildings, grounds & compounding, toilets, water)



Community health

We sustainably improve the basic health conditions of people by improving:

- Access to health services
- Sanitation facilities
- Awareness of health & hygiene issues

Projects: Treatment through health centers and mobile clinics, Toilet construction & bin installation, Health & hygiene education

Youth development

We develop youth by:

- Educating them on their rights and helping them develop their life skills
- Creating career development opportunities
- Stimulating community volunteering

Projects: Youth clubs, Career development workshops & Community volunteering

We have two new projects in development: The Nepal Children's Home to house 50 orphaned, abandoned & street children and Community Learning Centre (CLC) to build on the sustainable educational programmes currently operating. More details can be found on our website.
